### SR 9/I-95 AT NORTHLAKE BOULEVARD (CR 809A) INTERCHANGE DESIGN PROJECT

Palm Beach County, Florida

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Public Information Workshop regarding the SR 9/I-95 at Northlake Boulevard (CR 809A) Interchange Design Project. This workshop will have an open house format with representatives available to answer questions. Design plans and project information will be available for public viewing. Please stop by at your convenience.

#### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- On I-95, add one auxiliary lane in each direction and resurface the mainline from south of the interchange to north of the Earman River Canal.
- Widen Northlake Boulevard by adding a fourth through-lane from Keating Drive to Sunrise Drive.
- Add triple-right and triple-left turns at I-95 northbound and southbound ramp exits
- Add dual left-turn lanes from southbound Keating Drive to eastbound Northlake Boulevard.
- Add dual left-turn lanes from westbound Northlake Boulevard to Gardens Towne Shopping Center.
- Add 5 to 7-foot wide bicycle lanes from west of Keating Drive to Sunrise Drive.
- Upgrade to LED street lighting on the I-95 ramps and on Northlake Boulevard from Keating Drive to Sunrise Drive.

- Construction Begins: **Winter 2024**
- Anticipated Completion: **Spring 2025**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$37.5 million**
